MINUTES

- Call to Order
 - A. Meeting Called to Order at 8:30AM
- II. Approval of Agenda
 - A. Moved, Seconded.
- III. Approval of Fall 2021 Meeting Minutes
 - A. Moved, Seconded.
- IV. Chair's Report (Wink)
 - A. We are officially in 50th year! Happy Anniversary MARAC.

There are 60 new people at conference; welcome and thanks for being here.

Tara Wink invites people to get involved in 50th Anniversary activities. There are virtual tours of facilities, or particularly interesting collection. Tara encourages people to look for the email announcement, Sara will resend. Anniversary committee chaired by Lauren Brown, John LeGoahec, Alex Plante. Alex is in charge of virtual tours and there is a form to fill out if interested.

- B. Fundraising
 - Tara announces there will be special fundraising for our 50th anniversary. First, Silent Auction, she encourages people to look at examples at sign in desk. Tara next announces that MARAC will be launching a 50 for the Future campaign similar to others in the organization's past. MARAC is asking for \$50 donation to funds. One that needs help is Graduate Scholarship fund. Trying to grow that fund and disaster relief fund.

- D. Tara updates on the MARAC Strategic plan as work has started for the plan for 2024 -2029. She mentions some of the accomplishments in last 5 years with last strategic plan including: mentoring program, started a diversity committee, had first virtual meeting and about to have second, offering more virtual opportunities, and there is a group of people on steering working on what the virtual environment will look like.
- E. Tara mentions that the Membership Match program has been reintroduced for the Harrisonburg meeting. Tara recommends members get involved as a way for people to learn how to navigate MARAC meeting. There were 20 matches at this meeting consider getting involved at College Park.

- B. She reports that she has done some work to increase things for inflation and announces that honoraria have been increased from \$250 to \$300.
- C. Amanda announces a new cancellation fee of \$5 to help cover credit card fees that MARAC is charged. She assures members that it will not apply to events low in cost such as HVAC online workshop that was \$10.
- D. She reiterates the information on the upcoming Fundraising Campaign: 50 for the future. Suggesting that the Disaster relief fund could use additional money because a disaster in the region would hit multiple institutions at once and there would be a lot of need. She also

highlights the need for funds for the Graduate scholarship as at the end of Q2 we only have \$944.00, which is not enough to give out an award, need to get up to \$1000 to award scholarships.
