Mid-Atlantic Archivist (MAA)

The Spring 2023 (Vol. 52, No. 2) issue of MAA published electronically on April 3, 2023. A social media post advertising the issue was posted April 4. The issue will be noted in SAA's *In the Loop* newsletter in mid-April.

This issue marked both the return of reviews with a book review of *Managing Business Archives*, and the beginning of a new preservation column, called *Preservation Post*. Other articles included the graduate student scholarship winner's piece; a tribute to former DSA winner, Dr. Sue Hamburger; an interview with the 2022 Arline Custer Memorial Award winner; and an article on the Appalachian Trail Conservancy Records.

The Summer 2023 issue is currently being planned with an estimated publish date of around July 1, 2023.

Social Media

There were 8 posts on The MARAC Blog, all of which were also shared on our socials as well. On Twitter, we had 13 tweets and retweets from related users, with about 1200 impressions on the tweets, 260 profile visits, and 4 mentions. On Facebook we had 33 posts by me and other members of

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the group. Our most popular posts were those about the conference, with the top one having more than 1,200 views, and professional development opportunities from some organizations in the group. 55 different people posted and commented, and we gained about 10 new people since January. You can expect these numbers for both Twitter and Facebook to increase in the next month or so, with the virtual conference happening and later postings about the virtual poster sessions and virtual tours following.

Technical Leaflets/Practical Archivist: A Technical Leaflets Series

- Completed edits on the first draft of the reparative description leaflet. Return of our edits to the author is pending a final discussion with the editorial board scheduled to occur on April 20.
- Compiled a list of potential reviewers to contact for peer review.
- Updated the call for proposals on the MARAC website and sent it out to the MARAC email list and social media feed.
- We were put in contact with Krista Hanley at the Dickinson Print Center to begin the process of creating a new design for the Practical Archivist. Need to follow up with Krista to begin the redesign process.
 - The editorial board thought that a historic map showing the MARAC region might be a good starting point for a title page graphic.

Additional News

Co-Chairs met with colleagues from the Education and the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committees to discuss the development of a template or guidelines for conference presentations to ensure equitable access to all attendees and patrons. The discussion included options for a template and options for guidelines, with unanimous agreement that guidelines and examples will best meet the intended goals. This work is continuing with an expectation to submit a draft to Steering in Summer 2023.

The Communications Committee is exploring frameworks to effectively expand its membership while retaining specialized internal groupings that focus on major tasks, like the *MAA* and the *Practical Archivist*. Framework discussion focused on the need for succession planning in specialized roles as well as for creating opportunities for newer members to gain experience while incrementally increasing committee responsibilities. Frameworks discussed include that in place with the Custer Award Committee, wherein committee members progress towards leadership roles while receiving training by senior committee members.



Members of the Communications Committee are continuing to explore opportunities for the creation or purchase of MARAC-branded swag to be used as a fundraising tool. Initial surveys have revealed opportunities for the creation of t-shirts, specifically, that would generate funds to support MARAC-wide goals. The Communication Committee plans to reach out to the Scholarship Committee to help move the effort forward and to explore any potential for engaging one of MARAC's Members-at-Large in the project.
