At the July 31st deadline for Custer Award submissions, the committee received 12 nominations- 7 books and 5 articles. This number was slightly down from 2022 (16 nominations) and 2021 (22 nominations). All submissions were received electronically this year.

The Committee continued to add to and revise the list of outlets and organizations we sent the call for nominations to- notably adding all university presses in the MARAC region this year.

Committee members are currently reviewing nominations and will submit scores to determine the book and article prize winners by October 1st.

Finding Aids Committee Report MARAC Steering Committee Meeting October 19, 2023

The C. Herbert Finch Award was awarded to the University of Pittsburgh Library System for the web site the <u>August Wilson Archive</u> [https://augustwilson.library.pitt.edu/].

The <u>August Wilson Archive</u> website provides access for researchers interested in utilizing the collection and learning more about Pittsburgh native and famous playwright, August Wilson (1945-2005), and his work. Wilson is best known for his American Century Cycle, a collection of ten plays that chronicle the Black experience throughout each decade of the 20th century. The website includes access to the digital exhibit, "August Wilson in Place," and to the collection finding aid. It also provides information about physical exhibitions, related events, and ongoing opportunities that utilize the collection and create community engagement.

The website does an excellent job of promoting and providing access to archival materials and related resources in a meaningful, organized, and well-designed way. The website is engaging and effectively encourages users to utilize and learn more about the collection through the resources it provides.

The committee is looking forward to the 2024 Finding Aids Award review and will accept nominations following the announcement that the committee is accepting submissions due December 31, 2023.

Mid-Atlantic Archivist (MAA)

The Fall 2023 (Vol. 52, No. 4) issue of MAA published electronically on September 28, 2023. A social media post advertising the issue was also posted on September 28. This was the first issue published by the new editorial team. The issue will be noted in SAA's *In the Loop* newsletter in mid-October.

This issue included a book review of *Urgent Archives: Enacting Liberatory Memory Work*, and an article for the preservation column about identifying and dealing with moldy collections. Other articles included an update on MARAC's current strategic planning; an introduction to MARAC's new accessibility guidelines for presenters; an article on a major reappraisal project at Penn State; and news about MARAC's Mid-Career group's activities.

The MAA team has established guidelines for a new section, In Memoriam, that will be included in the publication as needed and will follow the Caucus News section. Submitters will contact the MAA email maa@marac.info with a short obituary for current or previous MARAC members who have recently died. They can edit an existing obituary to focus on the member's professional achievements and can contact Sara

Predmore for details about their MARAC participation (for individuals who have been recently active in MARAC). The MAA Style Guide will be updated to include this information for those submitting content for the In Memoriam section. This will both streamline the process and be equitable in honoring our colleagues.

The editorial team updated the rate card with new advertising editor information, as well as the contact information printed in each issue to utilize only the <u>maa@marac.info</u>. This action was taken in order to streamline communications from members and contributors, to ensure continuity of the publishing process if members are unable to respond, and to prevent single-point-of-failure communications that were previously caused when using individual personal emails.

The advertising editor reached out to 8 more possible advertisers/vendors for future issues and had either negative or no response. Lucidea is going through some organizational changes and would like to be approached in the new year.

The MAA team is exploring the possibility of expanding slightly to include a Caucus News editor. The Winter 2024 issue is currently being planned with an estimated publish date of early- to mid- January 2024.

The Practical Archivist: MARAC Technical Leaflet Series

Completed Work

- Renewed "Provisional ISSN" with the Library of Congress
- Contacted and confirmed two peer reviewers for current manuscript (inclusive and reparative description) that will be reviewed by mid-November with goal to publish by the end of December 2023
- Updated CFP for Fall 2023, which will be distributed at the meeting in Saratoga Springs. (Renae Rapp will be there.)

Current Work

- Update MARAC website to reflect recent updates, CFP for future issues of the new publication
- First Editorial Board meeting, with all four members. Will be held soon to review our goals for the rest of the calendar year
- Revising the style guide for authors (Molly/Chatham University and Emily Johnson/VA Museum of Fine Arts)
- Streamline layout/standardization of publication to enhance efficiency: Updating the graphic design/layout of the publication to parallel *Mid-Atlantic Archivist*

Future Work

- Transfer Google Drive content
- Revise guide for peer reviewers
- Over the summer, we received a manuscript on textile care. We need to contact the author for a more detailed proposal document for us to review.

Social Media

We've had five blog posts go up on the WordPress, and based on some new stats features from WP we had 814 views and 707 visitors; this is the monthly totals added together so it may not represent 707 *unique* visitors, but we had about 100 views and visitors for July and August, while September saw 563 views and 499 visitors. All blog posts were shared on X (Twitter) and Facebook as well.

On X we had 14 posts and reposts, resulting in 1385 impressions, 48 profile visits and 4 new followers. Traffic on X has slowed a good amount over the last few months, so these stats aren't surprising. Their analytics site is also undergoing changes and is lacking some of the information we might usually have regarding top tweets. On Facebook, 143 people have posted or commented since the end of July. There have been 133 posts both by admin and users, usually focused on job postings, professional development opportunities, and MARAC news related to meetings or committees. Our page was viewed by more than 5,000 people in that time period.

Since late July we've had 578 views of our videos, with a total watch time of 27.6 hours. We have four new subscribers, and 12,470 impressions (how many times thumbnails were shown to subscribers), and an average click through rate of 2.1%.

Additional News

The Committee met on October 10, 2023, prior to the Saratoga Springs meeting. They plan to meet again sometime around December 2023, before the winter Steering meeting.

Previously the Committee had been tasked with looking into MARAC branded "swag" but it was determined that was outside the scope of the committee as it currently stands.

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MARAC Education Committee Report 19 Oct 2023

Activities and ongoing tasks:

- The August Copyright Workshop (Advanced) was well received and had full registration. It was facilitated by Ed. Comm. Chair Colleen Bradley-Sanders.
- Elizabeth Wilkinson obtained ACA credit codes for the Saratoga workshops.
- Mae Casey submitted changes to the Education Committee pages for the website.
- Kay Lewandowska has resolved most issues with DRUM, there are a few outstanding questions about some previous recordings that Workshop Coordinators Elizabeth Wilkinson and Amy MacDonald are working to answer. Recordings of the virtual workshops may now be uploaded to DRUM and made public after 12 months.

Proposal

The Education Committee would like to revise the pricing structure for workshops by offering MARAC's student members a 50% discount on registration fees, and also by raising the fees, either for 2024 or starting with the Spring '25 in-person meeting. Fees were last raised in Fall '21 from \$45/90 to \$50/10. Increased honorariums and expenses reimbursements make it more difficult to break even on a workshop.
